All papers are sourced from well-managed, sustainable forests and their vast supply-chain hold many environmental accreditations. In addition to this, they hold a Climate Change Agreement along with ISO14001, ISO9001, FSC, PEFC and offer Carbon Balancing via The World Land Trust. They achieved a E2B Silver award for energy improvements along with an E2B Gold award for recycling; 98.5% of all their waste is recycled.

To ensure that your copies arrive in pristine condition and with the environment constantly at the forefront of our minds, all cartons are manufactured from 100% recycled materials and they are fully recyclable. They can be widely recycled at waste collection sites and/or collected by a variety of schemes across the country; please check locally for facilities within your area.

As we strive to become "plastic free", we have also switched our magazine wrappers from polythene to a paper-based product as these can be recycled easily at home and/or within any place of work.

We distribute our titles to our readers using a minimum amount of transportation, via electric vehicle where possible, and are constantly looking for improvements which will have a positive outcome on the world around us.
